Jurisdiction and responsibilities: The Officers and Committee members of the society holding the licence are deemed responsible for organising and conducting the show safely and in accordance with Rules and Regulations of the Kennel Club and agree to abide by and adopt any decision of the board or any authority to whom the board may delegate its powers subject to the conditions of Regulation F17. In doing so those appointed as Officers and Committee members accept they are jointly and severally responsible for the organisation of the show and that this is a binding undertaking (vide Kennel Club General Show Regulations F4 and F5)

All judges at this show agree to abide by the following statement: "In assessing dogs, judges must penalise any features or exaggerations which they consider would be detrimental to the soundness, health and well-being of the dog".  
Only undocked dogs and legally docked dogs may be entered for exhibition at this show.

The Society will ensure to the best of its ability that the event is run to Covid Safe guidelines. It is your responsibility to ensure you comply with national and local restrictions including advice given about non-essential travel in and out of locally affected regions (which must not be ignored) - in the interests of the safety of all participants this may give rise to a short notice refusal of entry at the society's discretion/. **Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition F (Annex B)**

- 1 These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition for any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee and may include reference for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A42.
- 2 a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the Show.  
b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
- 3 No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:  
a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee  
b) The removal of dew claws of any breed;  
c) Operations to prevent breeding provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown  
Nor must anything be done calculated in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive
- 4 The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
- 5 An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate) to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
- 6 Any objections by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

The Officers & Committee of the Löwchen Club do not accept responsibility for any products advertised or sold by Stall Holders and/or Trade Stands at this Show. Exhibitors are reminded that products on sale by Trade Stands for the preparation & grooming of dogs may not meet the requirements for the Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.

**DEFINITION OF CLASSES  
THE WORD DOG INCLUDES BOTH SEXES**

In the following definition, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club.  
Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows.

In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society.

In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e., 02/11/24

Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in breed classes but when entering in variety classes, wins in both breed and variety classes must be counted.

A first prize does not include a special prize of whatever value.

If an exhibitor reports before judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:

1) **WITHDRAWAL:** The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulation 20

2) **TRANSFER:**

a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.

b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class, Puppy class Junior or Yearling class, which is over age but under 12 calendar months, 18 calendar months of age or 24 calendar months respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy class, Junior class or Yearling class respectively for the correct colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling, to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.

c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct sex, colour, weight or height.

d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

**Baby Puppy** For dogs of four and not exceeding six calendar months on the first day of the show.

**Minor Puppy** For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the show.

**Puppy** For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the show

**Junior** For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the show

**Yearling** For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty four calendar months of age on the first day of the show

**Novice** For dogs that have not won a CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or THREE or more First Prizes at At Open or Championship Shows ( Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, Whether restricted or not)

**Post Graduate** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/GREEN STAR or FIVE or more First Prizes at Championship Shows, in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit or Open classes whether restricted or not where CC's where offered for the breed.

**Limit** For dogs which have not become show Champions under the Kennel Club Regulations or Under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/GREEN STARS or won 7 or more first prizes in all at Championship Shows in limit or Open Classes confined to the breed, whether restricted or Not at shows where Challenge Certificates where offered for the breed.

**Open** For all dogs of the breed for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the show.

**Veteran** For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the day of the show.

**Special Beginners** For owner, handler or exhibit not having won a CC or RCC

**GCDS** For dogs that have achieved their GCDS bronze certificate or above

**Special Pet Trim** For all Kennel Club Ltd registered Lowchen from 6 months of age shown in any pet Trim other than the acceptable standard show presentation.

**PUPPIES 4 - 6 MONTHS OF AGE (fully inoculated) may be entered in Baby Puppy Classes or Not For Competition.**

## SHOW REGULATIONS

The show will be held under Kennel Club Rules and Show Regulations. Every exhibitor making an entry or entries at this show shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by these Rules and Regulations and it is on this understanding only that the entries are received.

The owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of the dog at a Kennel Club licensed event must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car and caravan park and approaches.

Parent/Guardian, please note, well behaved children are welcome but those in charge of children will be held fully responsible for their actions and any damage caused within the environs of the show.

- 1 **OPENING OF SHOW:** The show will open at 9.00am
- 2 **ARRIVAL OF DOGS:** Dogs will be received at any time but it is the exhibitors responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when requested
- 3 **JUDGING COMMENCES :** 10.00am

- 1 **REMOVAL OF DOGS:** Exhibits may be removed from the show after their judging has been completed.
- 5 **CLOSURE OF SHOW:** The show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed
- 5 **ENTRY FEES** Members £ 25.00 per dog first entry. £5.00 per dog subsequent entries  
Non-Members £ 30.00 per dog first entry £5.00 per dog subsequent entries  
Not for Competition £ 2.00 including 4 - 6 month puppies

- 6 **PRIZE MONEY** No class prize money will be awarded at this show. Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup>– VHC

- 7 **REFUSAL OF ENTRIES** The committee reserve to itself the right to refuse entries.

- 8 **PUPPIES** Puppies under four calendar months on the first day of the show are not eligible for Exhibition.

- 9 **MATING OF BITCHES** Mating of bitches within the precincts of the show is forbidden

- 10 **BEST PUPPY IN SHOW** Where a Best Puppy In Show Competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and is unbeaten by any other puppy exhibited at the same show. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the day of the show. Where the Best In Show is a puppy it will also automatically be awarded Best Puppy in Show respectively. Where the Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it should automatically be Best Puppy in Show respectively, consequently, selection of Best Puppy In Show must follow the selection of Best In Show respectively. Best Puppy in Show must be selected from puppies which have been judged and which are unbeaten by any other puppy.

- 11 **BEST IN SHOW** Best In Show must be selected from the exhibits declared Best Of Sex. If a Reserve Best In Show is to be selected, the eligible dogs are those declared Best Opposite Sex and Reserve Best Of Sex to the exhibit declared Best In Show. The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and is unbeaten .

- 12 **Admission to Best In Show** Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.

- 13 Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them, This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such a practise would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practices will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11  
It is not acceptable to handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not to touch the ground when on the move. Exhibitors should note that such practices could constitute harsh handling and reports of such practise will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
- 14 All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulations F (Annex B) - Regulations for the preparation of Dogs for competition.
- 15 All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.

### 16 **DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS Show Schedule Notice**

Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help you through the do's and don't's travelling to and whilst at Kennel Club events

When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.

If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.

The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water to drink. Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around your dog. When at the show never leave your dog in the vehicle. Keep the dog in the shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.

Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time. Remember if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dogs welfare.

**WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.**

- 17 Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure The needs of their dogs(s) are met, and should not put a dogs health and welfare at risk by any action, default, Omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club rules and regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board For disciplinary action under The Kennel Club rules and regulations. The use of pinch collars, or prong collars, Is not permitted at any show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.

- 18 **NOT FOR COMPETITION:** Not for competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog must be recorded on the entry form and must be KC registered.

- 19 No modifications will be made to the schedule except by permission of the board of The Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine press wherever possible.

- 20 **DOG FOULING** Any owner, exhibitor, handler or any other person in charge of a dog is requested to remove immediately any fouling caused by their dogs and also any grooming waste at any Kennel Club Licensed Show within the licensed venue and the environs of that event, including the car parks and caravan parks and approaches. Adequate receptacles for the disposal of such fouling will be provided.

- 21 The Society will not in any way be responsible for any claim for injury or compensation or loss of property occasioned by or arising out of the holding of the show or by reason of any act of default of any person in attendance or present thereat.

The Lowchen Club can accept no responsibility for products advertised or sold by stand holders at this show.

- 22 **Exhibitors are at liberty to withdraw from competition but no entry fee can be refunded.**

### **REGULATION F9 EXHIBITION OF DOGS**

A) No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time whilst at the licensed venue including its environs, car park, caravan park and approaches.

B) The owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog at Kennel Club events must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under control whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car park, caravan park and approaches.

- 23 **REPLACEMENT OF JUDGES:** Should any judge be prevented from fulfilling his/her appointment, the Committee reserve the right to appoint another judge in his/her place.



## **Dogs in Cars on Hot Days**

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high

temperatures even on days considered slightly warm.

Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

Please note all cages and trolleys must carry identification Per Kennel Club Ltd Rules.

Please be vigilant at this show and immediately inform Officers and Committee if you see anything suspicious or of concern.

Please note the use of electrical equipment at this show is forbidden without permission of the Secretary.

Children under the age of 11 are the responsibility of, and must be accompanied at all times by a Parent or Guardian.
